Huon Regional Care continues Council's Strength for Seniors program

The Huon Valley Council's popular Strength for Seniors Program will continue under the auspices of Huon Regional Care.

Council's program commenced in December 2016 following feedback from seniors and health and wellbeing providers who wanted to access programs that improve the health and wellbeing of community members living with chronic health conditions. The program aims to help seniors remain active, strong, independent and allow them to remain in their homes and their communities.

The initial funding was limited and after it had stopped Council continued funding the program in Huonville and Dover.

The weekly sessions proved very popular with numbers at Huonville usually around 16-18, with a mix of male and female participants and 10 to 12 at Dover, all female.

Huon Valley Council Commissioner said it was wonderful that Huon Regional Care will continue to run such a popular and beneficial program.

"Huon Regional Care provide quality health care in the Huon Valley. It's great that they have decided to continue the Strength for Seniors program.

"We know that resistance (weights) training for seniors has so many health benefits, from bone health to improvements in balance, flexibility and reducing the symptoms of chronic diseases.
