Planning for future growth in Huonville-Ranelagh

A plan which will guide the long term growth of Huonville and Ranelagh for the next 15-20 years has been approved by Huon Valley Council.

The Huonville-Ranelagh Master Plan is a comprehensive framework for future development.

Mayor Bec Enders says there has been significant development in the Huon Valley recently and we expect to see much more in coming years.
